Destination	Darwin 🚗 Kakadu National Park
Meals included

Depart Darwin, the Northern Territory's capital and largest city, for a gentle three hours drive to the awe inspiring Kakadu National Park. Making up over 20,000 square kilometers, this world heritage listed park is home to both natural and cultural beauty, including crocodiles and migratory birds, as well as over 5,000 ancient rock art sites.

Suggested Activity: Estimated to be at least 20,000 years old, the World Heritage-Listed rock art on the walls Burrungkyu (Nourlangie) are an absolute must for any visit to Kakadu, situated only half hour from your accommodation

DAY 2

Destination	Kakadu National Park

With a free day to explore the ancient surrounds of Kakadu National Park, be sure to be up early enough to make the most of what will undoubtedly be an unforgettable day.

Suggested Activity: Yellow Water Billabong, known as Ngurrungurrudjba, is home to crocodiles, wild horses, buffalo and an abundance of native wildlife. Get the best vantage point from either a boat cruise or, take a stroll along the boardwalk.

After a scenic three hour drive you back through the Western edge of the park and back onto the Stuart Highway, the natural wonders that the Katherine region wait you, including the nearby Nitmiluk Gorge, the Katherine Springs or the Cutta Cutta Caves

Suggested Activity: Nitmiluk Gorge, also known as the Katherines Gorge, is arguably one of the Northern Territory's most well known attractions. With its hidden waterfalls, ancient Aboriginal rock art and abundance of wildlife, Nitmiluk Gorge will undoubtedly be one of the highlights of any trip to the Territory.

Today you leave the top end behind and head South to the remote town of Tennant Creek in the heart of the true Territory outback. Be sure to pre plan your stops, with the likes of Warloch, Daly Waters and Newcastle Waters, all offering rest stop facilities and supplies.

Suggested Activity: Just over half way between Tennant Creek and Katherine is Daly Waters, aptly named with its historic outback pub. Remarkably, this was the site of Australia's first international airport in 1934. After all, Australia's international airline, Qantas, stands for Queensland and Northern Territory Aerial Services. Since 1938 it has continuously operated as a licensed venue, making this remote watering hole as much of an outback museum as it is a pub.

Destination	Tennant Creek 🚗 Alice Springs

The thrill of the open road awaits you again today, as you leave Tennant Creek for the outback town of Alice Springs, sitting at the mouth of the MacDonalld Ranges. Be sure to again your stops along the way at place like Prowse Gap, Taylor Creek and Devils Marbles.

Suggested Activity: On your journey South is Karlu Karlu, also known as Devils Marbles. These "round boulders", as their name translates to, are a stunning rock formation that have almost become synonymous with the Australia Outback, and will make a worthwhile place for a final stop on your journey to Tennant Creek.

Today is at leisure for you to experience all that Alice Springs has to offer, the third largest township in the Northern Territory.

Suggested activity: A visit to the School of the Air and the Royal Flying Doctor Service will show you two of the facilities necessary for everyday life in remote locations.

With the MacDonalld Ranges in your rearview mirror, today set off for the majestic Kings Canyon, with its 300 metre high sandstone walls and hidden desert oasis at the canyon floor.

Suggested Activities: The historic "Hermannsburg", once a German missionary, now an Aboriginal community, is roughly at the half way point of today's driving. A quick stop here will still give you time to complete the 6 km Rim Walk at Kings Canyon in the afternoon, for those relatively fit travellers.

Destination	Kings Canyon 🚗 Uluru (Ayers Rock)

After the relatively short drive back into the desert, the highlight of your outback adventure awaits you. Uluru, an ancient rock formation in the middle of the red sanded desert, is situated in the Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, which also includes Kata Tjuta, also known as the Olgars.

Suggested Activity: Often overlooked by tourists with short stays at Uluru, Kata Tjuta is still a must for those with enough time to discover both. Taking of the two walking tracks at Kata Tjuta in the afternoon will still give you enough time to observe a breath taking sunset over Uluru.

Here you have all day to explore Uluru and its surrounds. It's best to fully plan your day's itinerary to get the most out of your stay. Tonight we have organise a sunset tour of Uluru.
